We will not turn away any person based on ethnic, racial, or cultural identity. We will not turn away any person seeking the solace of yoga practice.

We will not condone or tolerate any behavior that threatens the dignity or human rights of any person.

We will not condone or tolerate any language that threatens the dignity or human rights of any person. We oppose any and all laws that explicitly or implicitly create or seek to create division based on faith, place of birth, gender identity, sexuality, residency status, citizenship, ethnicity, race and/or cultural identity.

We will not comply with unjust laws that target people based on faith, place of birth, gender identity, sexuality, residency status, citizenship, ethnicity, race and cultural identity.

We oppose any and all legislation that seeks to deprive people of their rights to freedom of expression, freedom of religion, freedom of the press, privacy, freedom to travel without harassment, health care, housing, and employment.

We support legislation that seeks to affirm rights to freedom of expression, freedom of religion, freedom of the press, privacy, freedom to travel without harassment, health care, housing, and employment.

We support laws that explicitly or implicitly seek to reduce suffering, promote justice, and enforce equality. We call on all people of good will to stand with us, to be allies in the pursuit of unity, peace, honesty, compassion, friendliness, equality, and freedom and to hold us and each other accountable to these values.
